

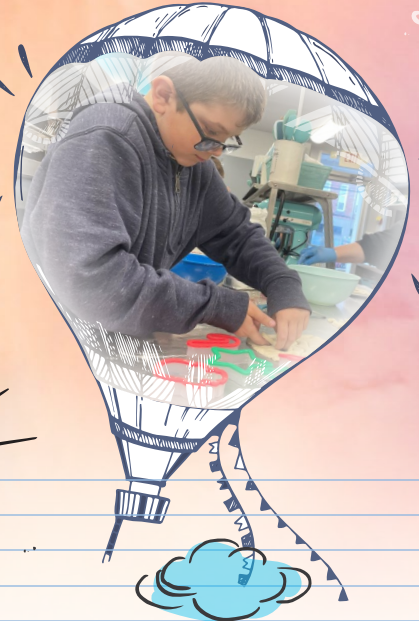

FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Friends of the Community Foundation, Serving Howard, Clinton and Carroll Counties:

2021 was marked by momentum and milestones

for the Community Foundation.

Like everyone, we learned how to deal with the coronavirus pandemic. We've learned to be flexible, adaptable and when necessary to adjust the way we work, ensuring we continue to have a vibrant presence in the communities we serve.

We reached several important milestones in 2021. The Community Foundation of Howard County celebrated its 30th anniversary, and we have grown considerably over three decades. The idea of the Foundation started with a \$10,000 grant from the United Way of Howard County in 1989 – that vision led to our incorporation in 1991. Today, the tri-county assets managed by the Foundation are more than \$113 million and total funds have grown to more than 540, further strengthening the charitable services in Howard, Clinton and Carroll counties.

The value of an organization like this is measured in its longevity. An important marker in our 30-year milestone has been expanding the Foundation's focus into more of a "community-leadership" role across our three counties. This really shows the value of the Foundation's history and how well-positioned we are to continue our charitable mission and help our communities in the future.

Clinton County joined the Community Foundation family in November 1996, so celebrating its 25th year as an important philanthropic partner was paramount.

The generosity of donors in Clinton County remains strong. Since 1996, the Clinton County Community Foundation has made grants of more than \$12.5 million to help the community be a better place. This amount includes approximately \$9.67 million in grants and \$2.86 million in general scholarships, with an additional \$3.1 million in Lilly Endowment Community Scholarships.

We came up with a creative way to celebrate the occasion. The Foundation provided \$25,000 to Clinton County nonprofit organizations through a series

of random \$2,500 drawings throughout the year, administered by the Foundation's Services Committee members. This was a special way to say "thank you" to the area nonprofit organizations that are so essential in helping us connect donors to the resources and causes important to them and the community.

We will continue commemorating our longevity in 2022 when the Carroll County Community Foundation celebrates its 25th anniversary. Part of this celebration includes building on our growth in Carroll County by offering two competitive grant cycles that will help nonprofits in their role as providers of vital programs and services.

We're especially proud of having been recertified as a National Standards for U.S. Community Foundations organization. This is the United States' highest philanthropic achievement for operational quality, integrity and accountability and is administered by the Council on Foundations. We have been certified since 2006. Being recertified confirms for our donors and supporters that they can be confident that our procedures are operationally and legally sound.

We have tremendous pride in our past, and we're excited about our future. As the end of 2021 approached, so did the near completion of an extensive upstairs renovation and expansion of our office in Kokomo. Our historic building is part of the Kokomo Courthouse Square Historic District, National Trust for Historic Preservation, and we're proud to update the space so the Foundation can stand and serve our tri-county region for many years to come.

Our milestones and continuing growth could not be accomplished without our donors and partner organizations working alongside us. Working with donors and honoring their wishes is always the best part of our day.

As always, you are welcome to stop by for a visit and a tour of our renovations.

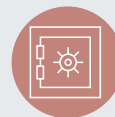

A NEW SHELTER SHOWER IN HOWARD COUNTY

For homeless and income-challenged individuals in the Kokomo, Indiana community, C.A.M. (Coordinated Assistance Ministries) is a safe and secure haven for temporary help.

Organized in May 1993 as a homeless day shelter with a faith-based mission, C.A.M.'s legacy of lives saved and dreams renewed is incalculable, but the need remains great. To help address that need, especially for residential clients who may need a higher level of care, C.A.M. recently began a capital campaign to relocate to a larger facility with expanded services to help local people as they work to rebuild their lives.

Sometimes, it's as basic as providing a place to sleep and shower. The new location had plenty of space, but only one shower. The organization quickly identified this as an inconvenience and potential safety concern with more resident clients on site; so C.A.M. sought grant funding from the Community Foundation of Howard County for a second shower stall.

Adding the second shower in the single-level facility further allows C.A.M. to support and accommodate clients with mobility issues. Both are important features that help C.A.M. provide that extra level of comfort – and security – for residents and staff on site by being able to better monitor client activities and help them with their daily needs.

EXPANDING EDUCATION IN CLINTON COUNTY

It's a worthy and achievable goal: offering quality pre-kindergarten instruction for every single 4-5 year-old child living in the Community Schools of Frankfort (CSF) district in Clinton County.

The report card reflects that progress is being made toward that goal. As recently as the 2017-18 school year, Clinton County was considered a desert for Pre-K learning opportunities. But a dedicated and resourceful team from CSF and the community started researching – and securing – many of the education and learning grants that were available. The first Pre-K classes were added for the 2018-19 school year. Ongoing assessments revealed there were still children in the county who could be helped, so additional classes were proposed.

Frankfort schools had the space but needed help to purchase the technology and instructional materials required for one of the new classrooms. The Clinton County Community Foundation is helping to address that cost, ensuring CSF has the capacity and the resources it needs to help young students begin a successful journey in education.

Funding is important as CSF and its community partners continue to refine and implement a strategy that is focused on growth and expansion. It further reflects the deep dedication of a community committed to achieving its goals, knowing that early childhood education is the start of the skilled workforce of tomorrow.



Two additional free pre-kindergarten classes were established by the Center Township of Clinton County so students will have more access to quality instruction.

Family Health Clinic

HELPING WITH HUNGER IN CARROLL COUNTY

Residents in Carroll County have several services and organizations available to them if they need assistance. Generally, the generosity of spirit and resources remain in balance with the level of need in the Carroll County communities.

Sometimes, a little extra help is needed, especially when that need is hunger. Area food pantries, food service providers and local grocery stores all play a role in ensuring income-challenged residents have access to the food their families need. But gaps remain often due to being unaware of the ways or the places to obtain help.

The Family Health Clinic of Carroll County has provided quality medical and support services to the community since 1995. Recently, the organization began to see that many patients had little or no food in their homes. Even with access to benefit services like the SNAP food-assistance program, many in the community faced social barriers that contributed to a lack of access to food.

Family Health Clinic's creative solution was a voucher program for emergency food sources, and the Carroll County Community Foundation is an important funding source. Vouchers help while a family is being enrolled in SNAP, for example. Or, if someone is not eligible for specific program benefits, the vouchers can be applied as a temporary solution while the clinic helps them sort out their options.

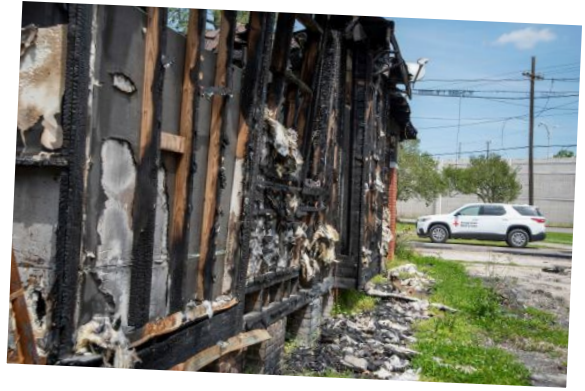

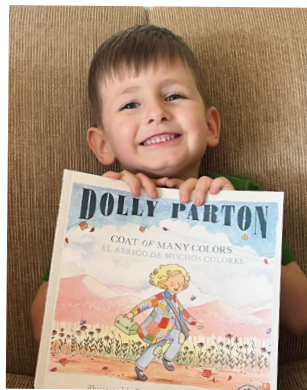
